

Important News!

To encourage modesty, promote unity and inspire pride in our school, **Alliance Christian Academy will enforce** the following dress code for the 2011-2012 school year. Parents are expected to ensure children come to school dressed properly and ready to learn!

All Alliance Christian Academy students will wear:

- **A SOLID COLOR POLO SHIRT EVERY DAY.** Polo shirts have a collar, a sleeve (short or long), and must fall below the waist so that when arms are fully extended overhead, absolutely no skin shows. This is the ACA “Hallelujah” test. Only the top 2 buttons may be open.
- **RED POLO SHIRTS** must be worn on Chapel days and fieldtrips.
- Jeans may be worn but may not be baggy or low-rise. No holes of any kind are permitted. No leggings may be worn. Khakis or slacks of any color may be worn.
 - Shorts or skirts may be worn but no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. No athletic shorts are allowed.
 - Shoes must be close-toed for all elementary students. Middle and high school students may wear sandals with a back strap.
 - Absolutely no facial hair.
 - Sideburns must not fall below MID-EAR. Young men’s hair must not fall below the back collar. No portion of the head may be shaved. All haircuts must be neat in appearance. No extreme hairstyles are permitted. Administration reserves the right to determine “extreme.”
 - No visible tattoos are permitted. No visible body piercing of any kind except ears for ladies.
 - During the winter months, heavy coats may be worn to school. However, only Alliance Christian hoodies or sweatshirts are allowed in the classroom and must be worn **over** a polo shirt.
 - In addition, during the winter, a plain colored sweater or cardigan may be worn over the polo shirt. Collar must be out. Students may also wear a turtleneck under a polo shirt.
- Athletes will be allowed to wear an approved team shirt on game days. Our Athletic Director will provide further info.

*Administration may approve a “dress down” day for students on occasion. The administration, faculty and staff reserve the right to deem **any** attire inappropriate for school.*
